

The OWL application process

Thank you for your interest in the OWL (Our Whole Lives) program at First UU. If you are completing this application (form on next page), please make sure to **carefully review “Information about Our Whole Lives (OWL) for 8th graders”** found on the OWL page of our website (uusociety.org), which contains important information how we run the program.

OWL Application (step ONE) expresses your desire and intent for your child to do OWL:

For the first 20 Applications we receive, the application “holds your spot.” Then, completing the three Registration steps (see below) confirms and “locks in” those (up to 20) who submit applications prior to the August deadline.

Deadline: First Monday in August.

If applications exceed available program capacity of 20 spots, we will form a waitlist.

OWL Registration (step TWO) confirms a place in OWL for those whose spots we held:

Accepted families will be invited to register during the first full week in August, at which time they must complete and return the following Registration information. **Registration Deadline for accepted participants: Fourth Monday in August.** Registration confirms a spot in OWL for those who have been accepted. If your Registration information is not complete by this date, and spots have become limited, your spot may be offered to a waitlisted student. Registration for OWL requires three things:

- 1. Complete the Religious Education registration form for the upcoming OWL Program Year, which will appear on our website (www.uusociety.org). In the Religious Education menu, go to “Register Now” for the link to the online form. Families registered the prior year will get an email when the new registration form is ready.
- 2. RSVP to Martha Dallas (martha@uusociety.org or 862-5630 x 28) to attend one of the OWL Parent Orientations, indicating the names of parent(s) attending. This is required of at least one parent in order for your child to participate. If your child has two custodial parents living locally, we ask that both attend if at all possible. OWL Parent Orientations are offered:
 - 12:15-2:15 PM on Sunday, September 25, (lunch provided)
 - 5:30-7:30 PM on Wednesday, September 28 (light supper provided)
- 3. Current Pledge/Registration Fee due: UU members or friends must have committed a financial pledge for the OWL year in question. Non-UU families must pay the Registration Fee of \$300 (Check payable to First UU Society. Write “OWL fee” in the memo line).

Please contact Martha Dallas at 862-5630 x 28 or martha@uusociety.org if these fees present a hardship for your family; some scholarship support is available, and ability to pay is NOT a factor in acceptance to OWL.

Late Registrations: If space is available, we will consider late Registrations pending sufficient time to process them. Spots available during this late timeframe will take several factors into consideration. Some precedence will be given to UU applicants, 8th graders, applicants who previously applied and did not get in, and applicants whose gender brings balance and diversity to the group as a whole.
