This congregational meeting will consider one question:

Shall the First UU Society of Burlington, Vermont vote to call the Rev. Karen G. Johnston as its next settled Senior Minister?

Eligibility to Vote: All members in good standing as of Sunday, April 16, 2023, and all Life Members of as Wednesday, April 19, 2023 are eligible to vote.

Calling a Senior Settled Minister requires a quorum of 30% of membership or 139 members both in person and on Zoom.

Life Members may vote by proxy. They will receive a paper ballot via USPS OR may vote in-person OR on zoom. All other members in good standing may only vote in-person OR on Zoom.

Members attending in person may check in and receive their paper ballot beginning at 9:30 a.m. on the day of the meeting or between the service and the meeting in the Sanctuary. Members attending via Zoom may begin

checking in at 10:45 a.m. Once you check in on Zoom, you must remain in the Zoom meeting room until the meeting begins in order to vote.

Anyone may attend the in person meeting, however only members will be able to check in and receive a paper ballot. Only members will be allowed into the Zoom Meeting.

The Nursery will be open during the meeting. Older children are encouraged to join their parents in the Sanctuary to be a part of this historic election.

We are planning to live stream this meeting, but you will not be able to vote via the live stream. If you just want to watch the proceedings, please go to our website www.uusociety.org for a link to the live stream.
