FUUSB's art gallery is located on the second floor of the FUUSB Meeting House in a space called, The Arc Gallery. The gallery is for small displays of 2D artwork. Exhibits run for one month except during the summer when a single exhibit is up from June through August. All artwork is considered as long as it adheres to the society's guidelines which you can find below. Priority is given to FUUSB members and friends. If you have a body of work you would like to show please contact the Arc Gallery coordinator, Rodney Lowe via email at Rodney_Lowe@yahoo.com).

Space is allocated on a monthly basis. Artists are asked to set up during the first couple of days of the month and take their work down before the last day of the month, so the space is ready for the next artist. Access to the building is coordinated with the Arc Gallery Coordinator.

We will advertise each show on all FUUSB channels: uusociety.org, eNews and Community Messenger. Artists may want to consider a small "opening" during social hour on the first Sunday after their exhibit is hung. Volunteers may be available to help hang or break down your exhibit, but please coordinate this ahead of time, as it's not guaranteed.

This is a great opportunity for first time exhibitors wanting to show their art to a wider, friendly and supportive audience. For first timers it is also an opportunity to experience what it is like to hang a solo exhibit. The gallery co-ordinator is available for advice and guidance.

All work hung in the gallery should be appropriate for a multigenerational audience and must meet UU values and follow the FUUSB mission statement. The Arc Gallery coordinator and FUUSB staff have final say on what may and may not be exhibited.

All pieces must be labelled and priced (tag NFS if they are Not For Sale). Artists will coordinate pick up and receipt of payment directly with the buyer. The society will take no commission and so will not act as an agent in any way. Labels should be placed on the artwork itself or using a removable adhesive putty (e.g. Elmer's Tac 'N Stik). FUUSB carries no insurance for loss or damage to the artwork.

The hanging system is 14 separate vertical rods that can support more than one piece on each rod. There are individual hooks for a maximum of about 25 pieces, but this may be less depending on the size of each piece and how they are hung. Please check the gallery hanging system and the gallery itself before you sign up to use the space.

Linear wall dimensions are:

Large (slightly concave) Wall to left of Whitney Young Room

- 9'6" wide
- Three or four hanging rods
- There is one hook available on that wall suitable for an Artist's Bio and Statement.

Large (slightly concave) Wall to right of Whitney Young Room

- 9'6" wide
- Three or four hanging rods

Medium Wall on the elevator shaft wall

- 7' wide
- Three or four hanging rods
- Also has a metal radiator that could be used for small light weight items such as quest sign in book, catalog, artist bio, artist statement, business cards etc.

Medium wall backing onto the Minister's office

- 5' wide
- One or two hanging rods
- Also has a small table that could be used for small light weight items such as quest sign in sheet, catalog, artist bio, artist statement, business cards etc.

Narrow wall on landing leading up to 2nd floor

- 4' wide
- Single hanging rod
- This is visible from the side entryway and an eye-catching piece of work hung here would remind people to come up and look at your exhibit.
